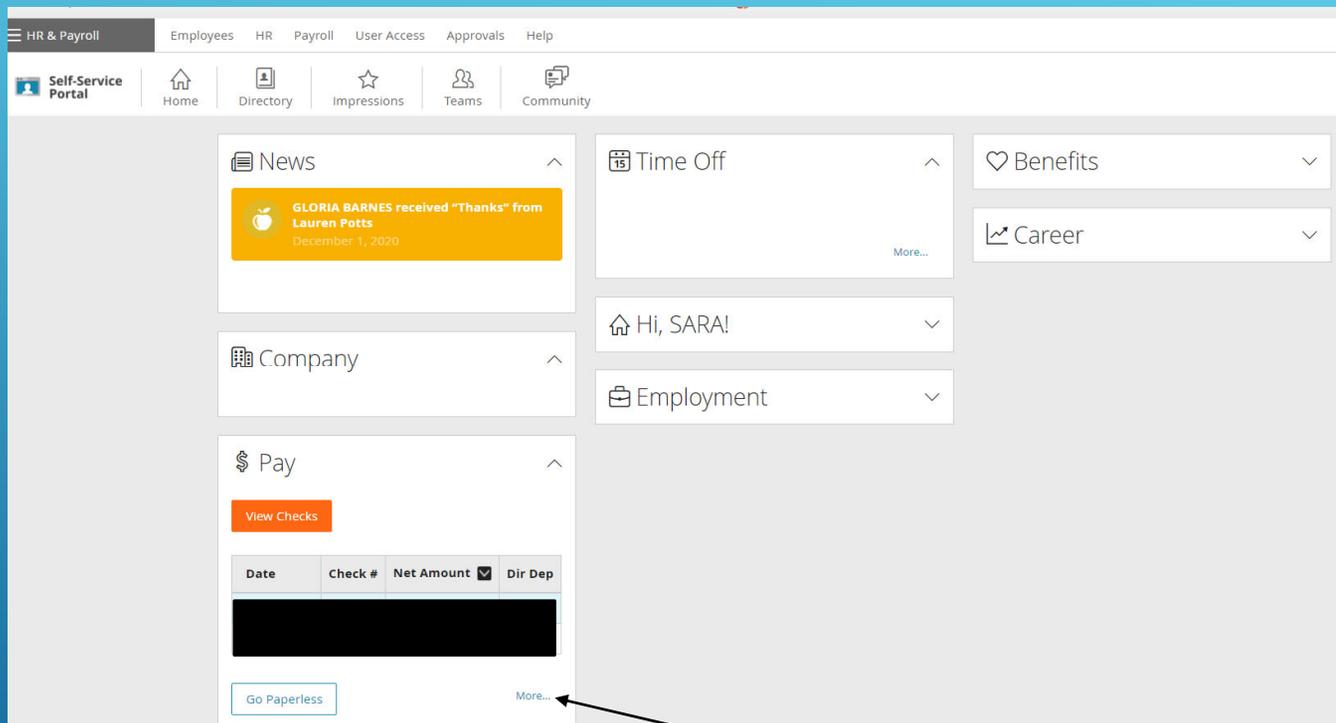

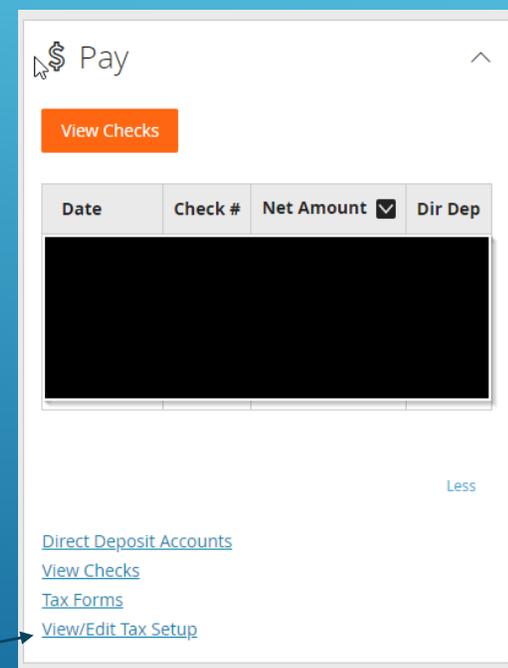
How to update your Tax Exemptions

Step 1: Log into you Self Service Portal at Paylocity.com, not the app.



Step 2: Look for the Pay tile and click More....

Step 3: Select View/Edit Tax Setup



Step 4: Depending on if you want to update your Federal Income Tax or your State and Local tax. You will select the hyperlinked blue writing for your update.
